- Managing stakeholders' interests
- Sustaining new practices

The workshop is organized by PhD candidates from CEROS (University Paris Nanterre). Its primary aim is to provide an opportunity for all PhD candidates in management sciences from CEROS and CEREFIGE to present and discuss their research. Plan du campus - Université Paris Nanterre - Portail institutionnel












Plan du campus de Nanterre - Université Paris Nanterre
